YOUR BEST CHOICE

Terry Allen who followed more than 20 years of success as a player and coach at the University of Northern Iowa with five seasons as head coach at the University of Kansas, is coming up on his fourth season as head coach of the Missouri State Bears

It's hard not to get excited about the job Terry Allen has done in his first three years as Missouri State head football coach, but Allen himself knows there are no quick fixes in the Valley, but he and his staff bring to the table a knowledge and understanding of the league and the division in which the Bears play that gives them a solid blueprint for what they plan to achieve.

At the time Allen left UNI after the 1996 season, his 75-26 record made him the winningest coach in Gateway Conference history and gave him a .743 winning percentage. His Panther teams won or shared Gateway titles from 1990-1996 and competed in the NCAA 1-AA playoffs each of his last seven seasons at UNI. He was the Gateway Coach of the Year five times in his last six seasons at UNI. .

In his career, Allen tutored nine players who are on NFL rosters in 2004, including Arizona Cardinal all-pro quarterback Kurt Warner. Warner was the 1999 and 2001 NFL Offensive Player of the Year as a St. Louis Ram. Former all-pro linebacker Bryce Paup, the 1995 NFL Defensive Player of the Year with the Buffalo Bills, also played for Allen.

TEAM CAMPS

Practice divided into 3 segments.

1. Individual (MSU coaches instruction)
2. Group work (inside run & skeleton)
3. Team work (11 on 11 pro tempo)
4. Certain practices are video taped with “chalk talk” and nightly review
5. Viewing rooms available for teams

WHAT TO BRING

1. Bedding for twin beds, pillow & towels
2. Toiletries (shampoo, toothpaste, soap, etc.)
3. Helmet, shoulder pads, jersey, girdle pads, pants, and knee, tail and thigh pads
4. Football shoes, tennis shoes
5. Shorts, socks, jocks, and T-shirts

Insurance – The MSU Football Camp has arranged for secondary medical insurance policy that will work in conjunction with the parent's primary policy. This policy will pay for only sport-related injuries that occur while attending camp activities. A certified trainer will be on staff at all times.

HOUSING

Campers will stay in one of our excellent residence halls with a roommate. The residence hall is centrally located within walking distance to all areas campers will have access to during camp. Bedding will not be provided. **On all lost keys a \$30 fee will be levied.** This necessitates a lock change to be ordered, in addition to cutting a new set of keys.

FOOD

Buffet meals are served in the Blair-Shannon cafeteria with plenty of different selections. Meals include dinner on the first evening, 3 meals on full days and breakfast on the last morning of camps for resident campers. For non-resident campers all meals, except breakfast, are included.
